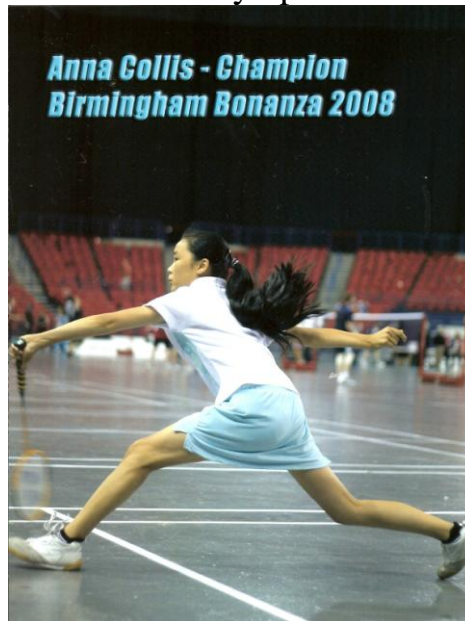


Anna Collis – Annual Report 2009/10

Anna has been playing badminton for 3 ½ years. During this time she has made exceptional progress and currently is ranked at number 3 in her age group nationally and plays number one girl for County in her age group. Although only 3 she has played up through the age groups often competing for county and in National tournaments against the Under 17s. This season she has been regraded as an U17 Gold player.

She has played National, International and European Tournaments and there is a summary of her short but successful career below, the summary is a brief description of her most important achievements.

Anna is highly motivated, determined and focussed. She spends 14 hours on the court and in training each week. She wants to make a career in the sport and her ultimate goal is to be an Olympic medallist.



Summary of 2007-2008 Season

5 Silver medals (finals)

5 Bronze medals (semi finals)

During the season she moved through the gradings from an ungraded player at the beginning of the season through Grade 3 and Grade 2 to a Gold/Grade 1 player at the beginning of the 2008-09 season.

In July 2008 Anna competed in the Vancouver Junior International Tournament. The results were as follows

U13 Singles Winner	–	Gold medal

In August 2008 she competed at the Yehlex Bonanza Tournament in the Under 15s (although only just 12)

Anna finished the season ranked at number 19 in the country in her age group.

Summary 2008-09 Season

Anna began the season ranked at number 4 in her age group and before Christmas she was ranked at number 3 where she stayed for the rest of the season.

Her main achievements during the year were:

Anna had to play in Gold Tournaments in her age group.

She won 5 bronze medals (semi-finals) in the Under 17 Bronze Tournaments during the season
